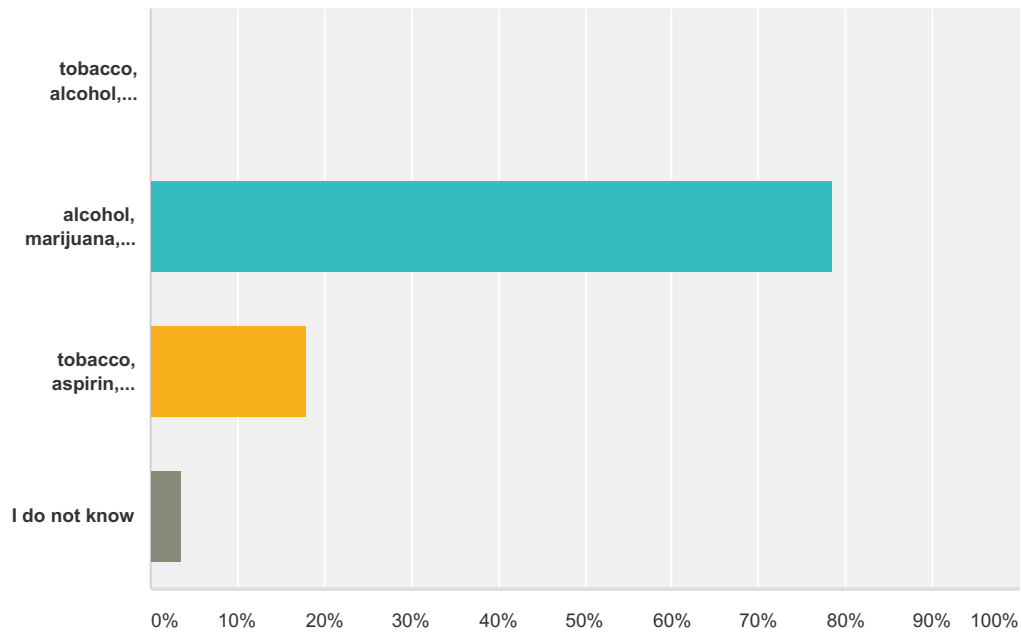


### Q1 The term Gateway Drugs refer to which drugs specifically?

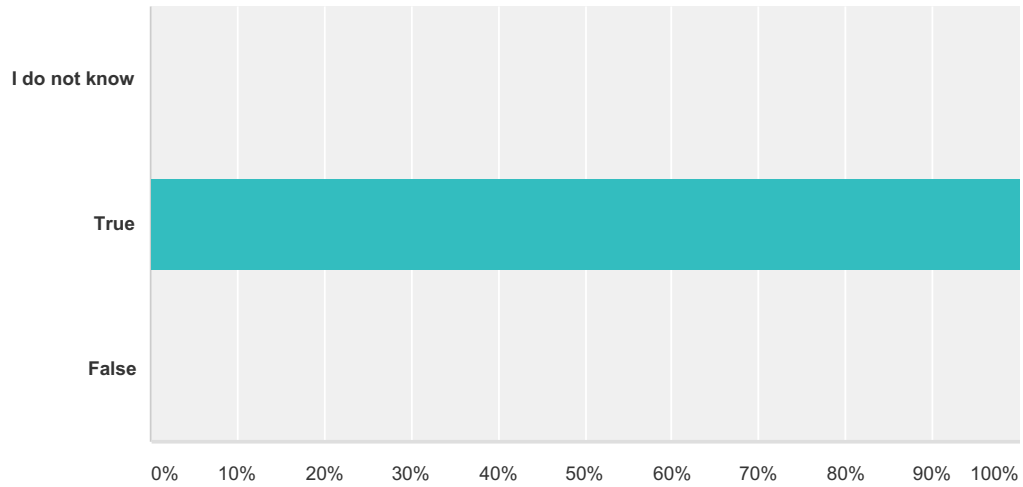

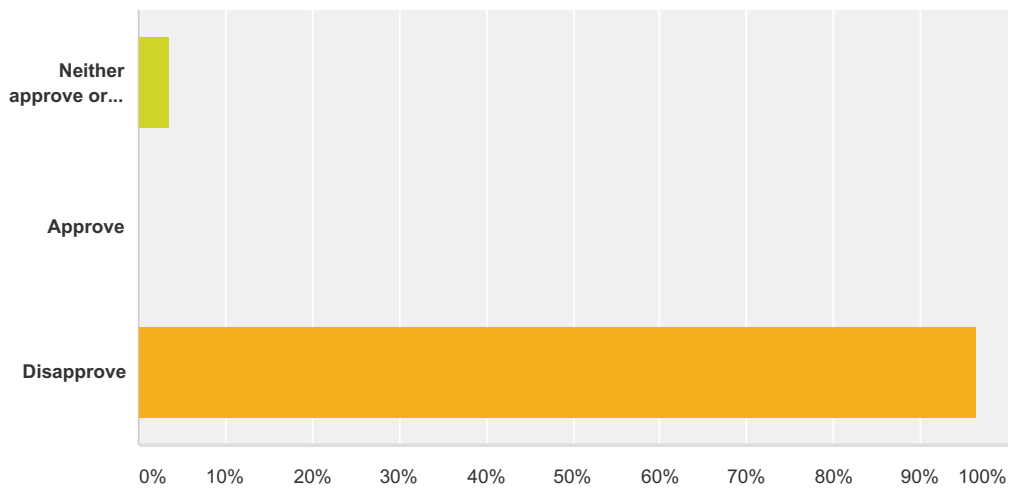

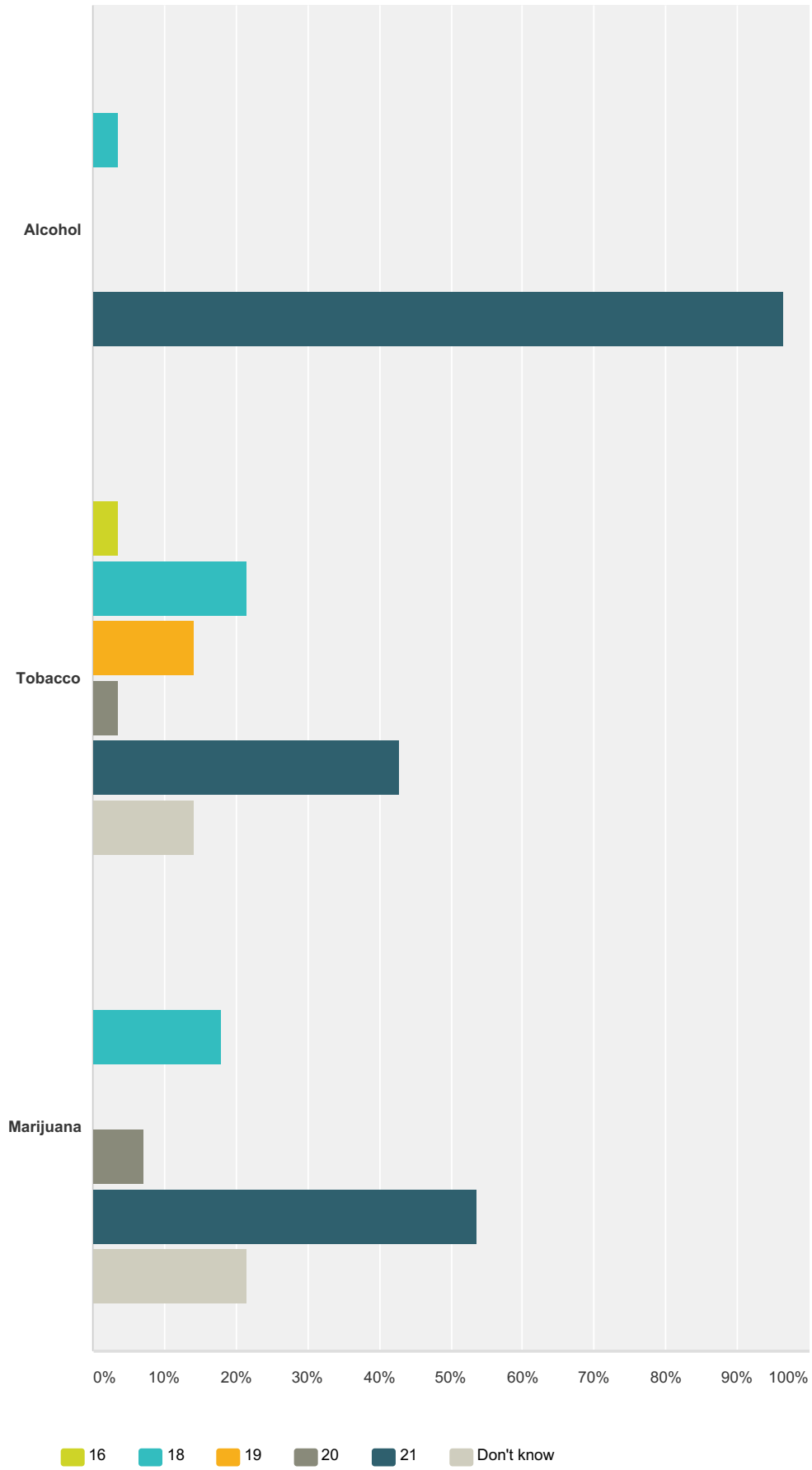

**Q4 At what age must you be to legally purchase and use**

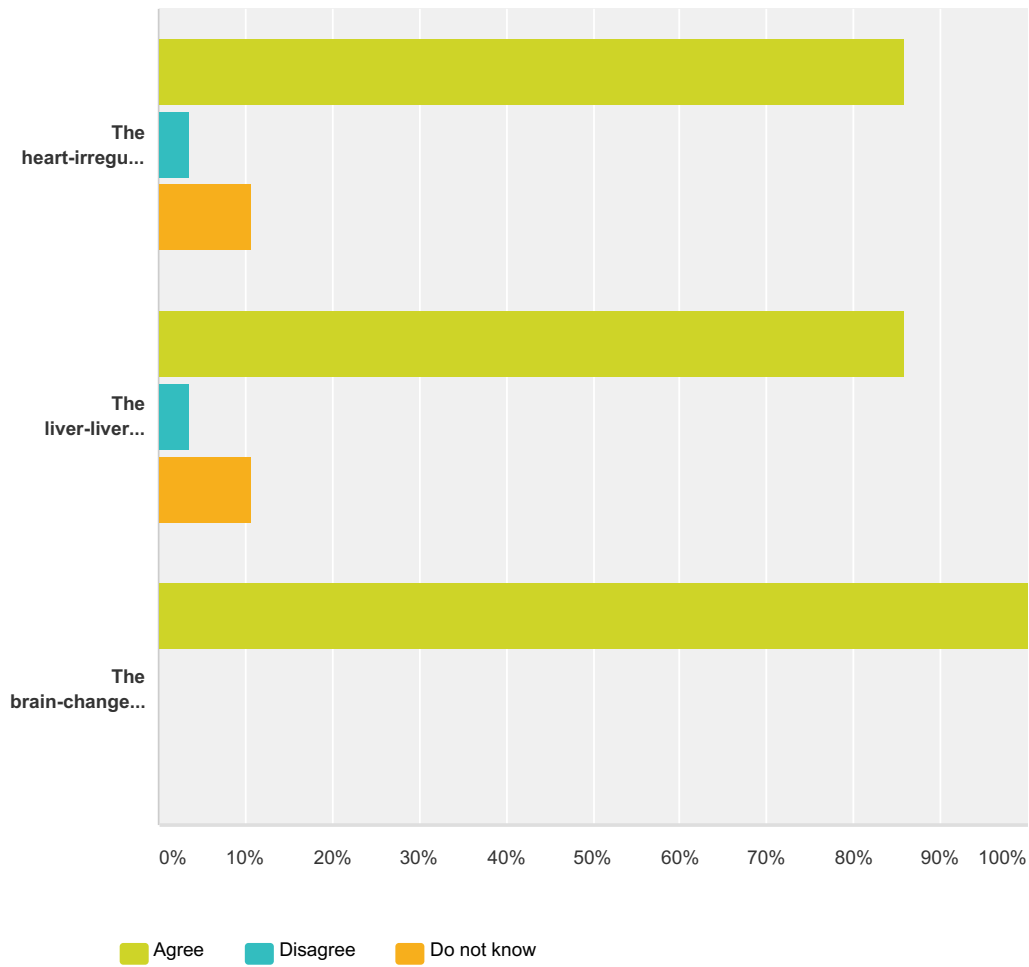

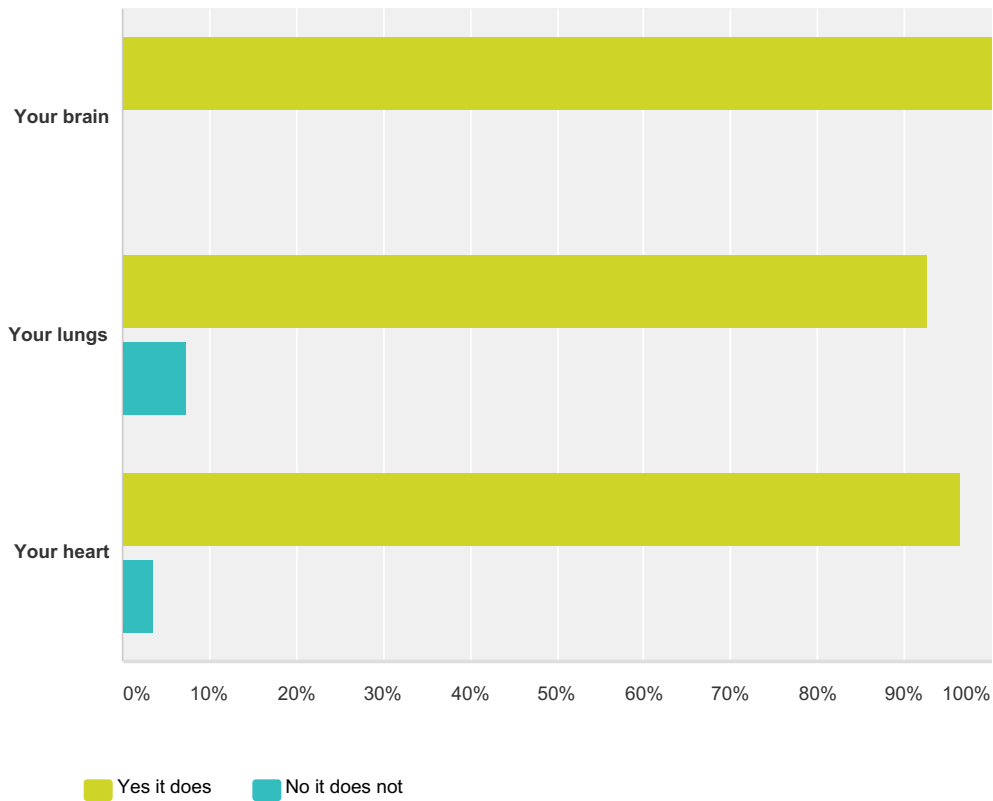

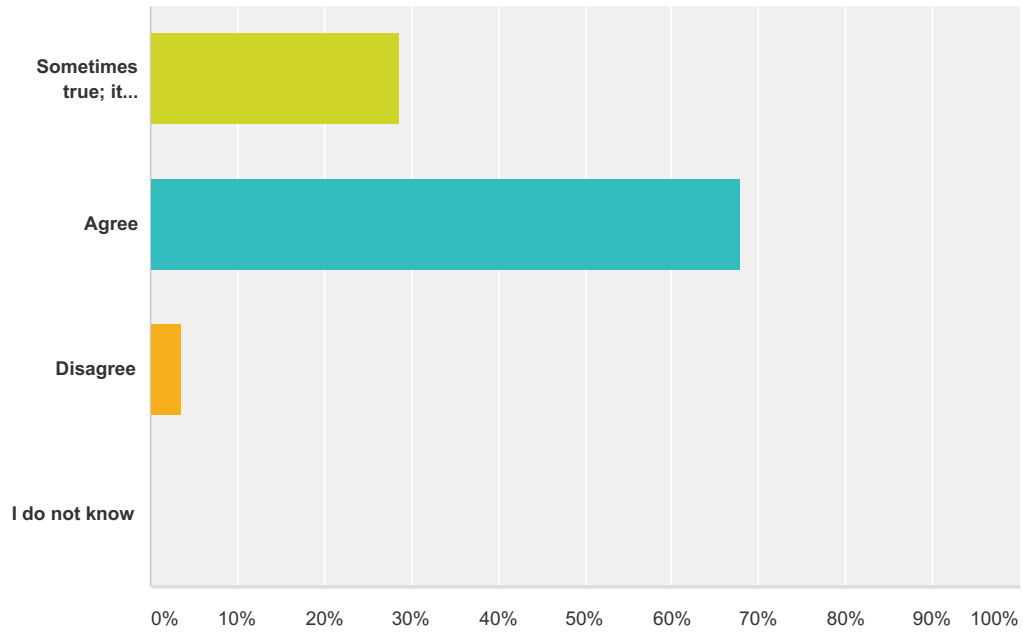

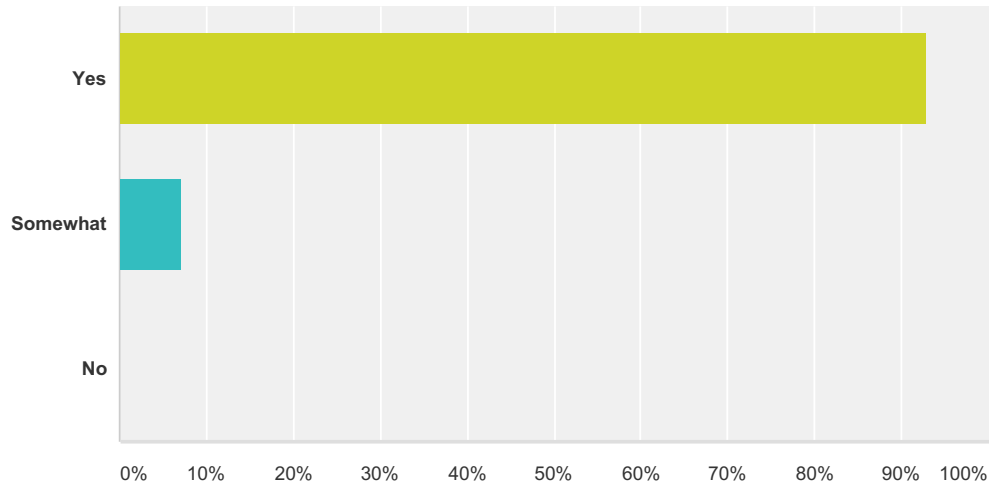

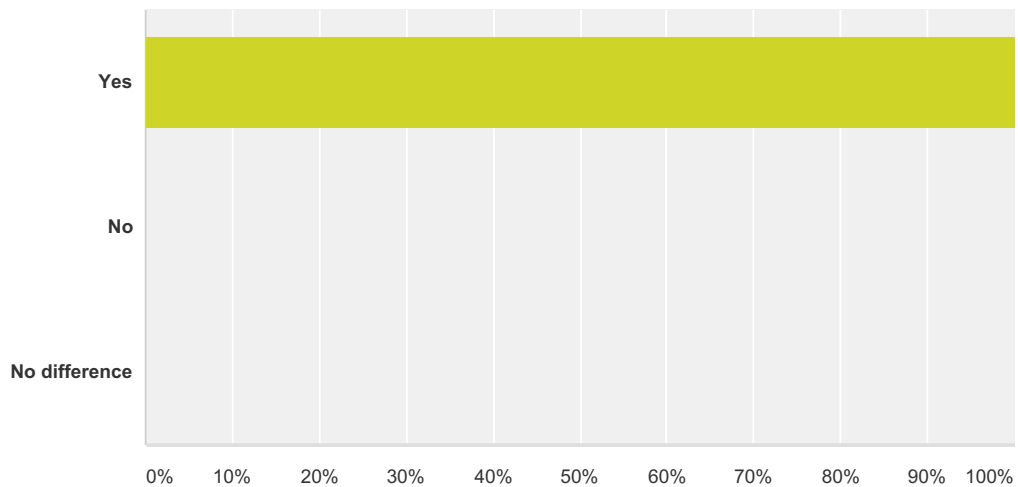

**Q12 Do you feel you have a better understanding of what can happen if a person uses drugs or alcohol?**

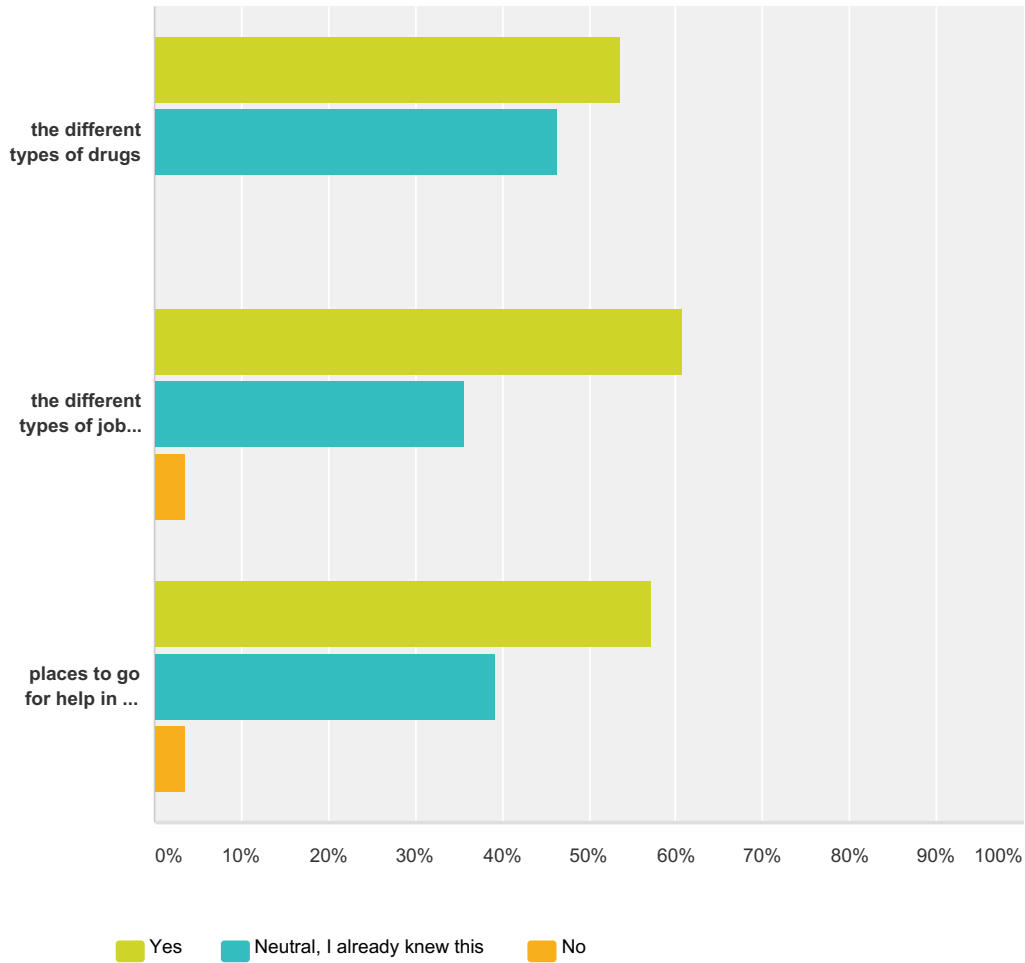

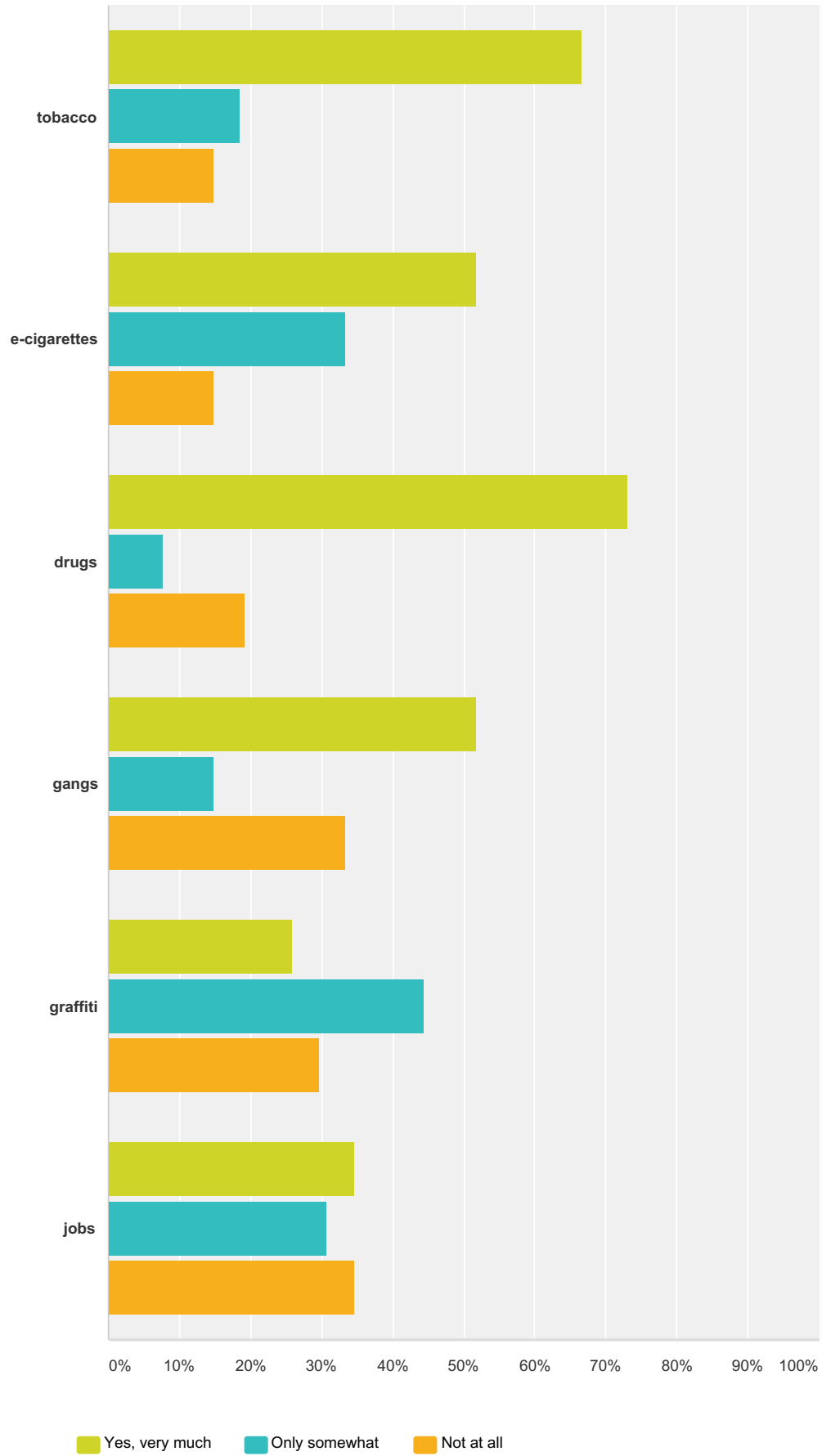

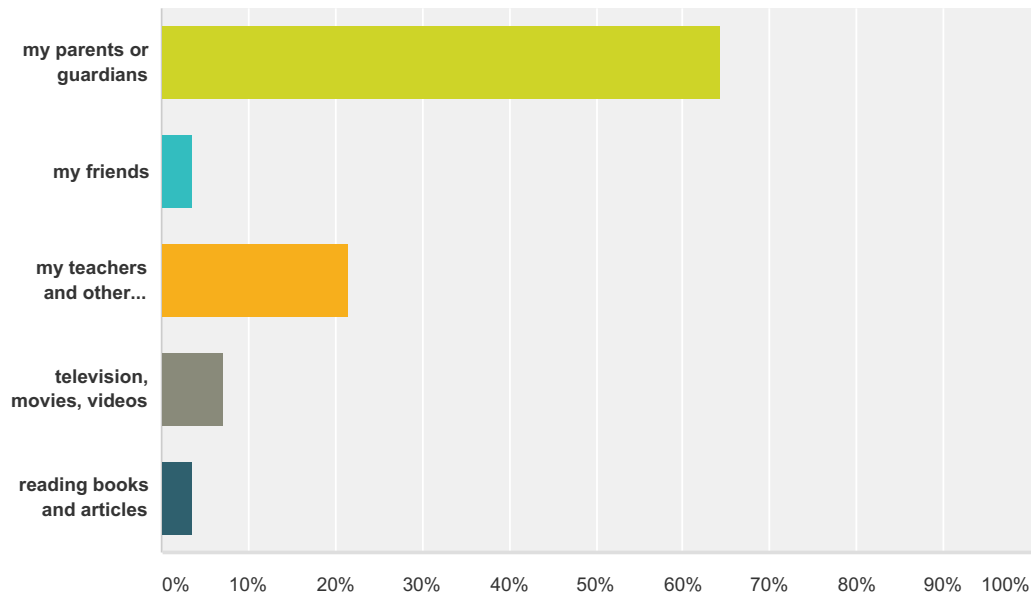

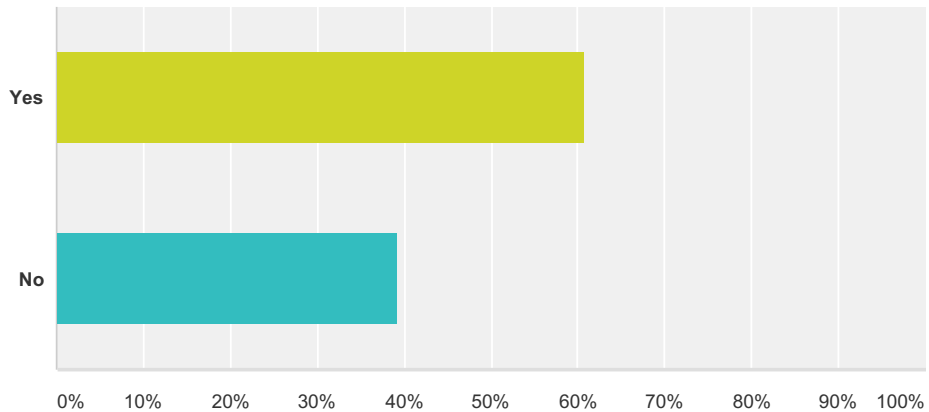

### Q17 Was this your first visit to the Lake Tahoe Community College?

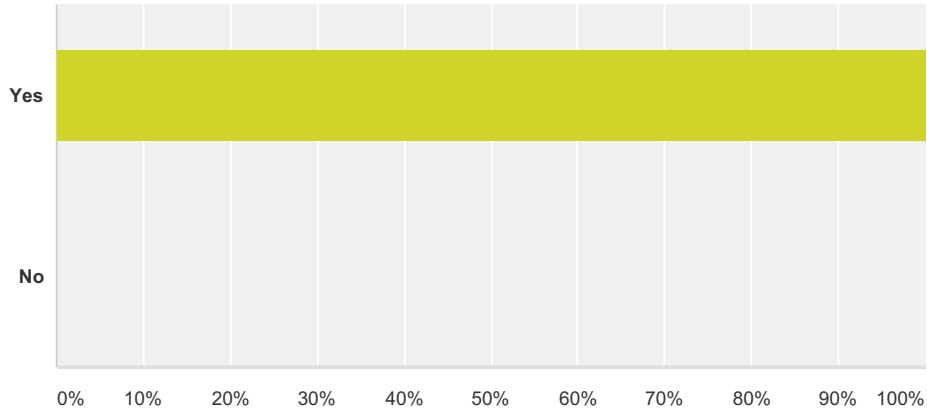
