

The Drug Store Project

Actor Supervisor

Please meet group number that you are assigned to out in the LTCC Parking lot. California National Guard will be holding up a sign

Your responsibility is to be the personal escort of the actor student for the day.

1. As the students **are getting in line**, look for the student with the name badge that is highlighted with a red border. This individual is a volunteer 7th or 8th grader who has been through the program themselves! They are now “paying it forward” so let them know we appreciate that.
2. Upon arriving at the scene, direct the “actor for the day” to the staff in charge at the scene. They will tell the actor what to do during the scene with your support. Your notes are included.
3. The student is an actor **ONLY** during the main program. They are not acting during: CALSTAR, K9, CCC, Explorers, Bomb Squad, or Search and Rescue.

Student Actor Jobs entail:

Gateway Drugs: (Location: A251)

Task: None. They are observers as are the rest of the group. The group will then head to the Pharmacy. Please get the student actor with you at the end of the line.

The Pharmacy: (Location: A208)

Task: Have the Student Actor stay with you at the back of the line **before entering**. Signal to the vignette staff who the actor is. At the Pharmacy Scene there will be a baggie of drugs that the student will put into pocket as directed from the vignette staff. The student will be directed with their classmates to view the drugs. There will be a bag of drugs on the table that they will take even though they were told not to touch anything. They need to grab it quickly and put it in their pocket or under their shirt. At that point they will be arrested. As they are arrested and removed from the room, follow them out. Take them to the next vignette: Juvenile Hall.

Juvenile Hall: (Location: A211)

Task: Get them to Juvenile Hall. The vignette staff will tell them what to do. They are to look serious, and to look straight ahead, no talking unless

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the vignette staff talk to them. They will be removed by the Bailiff to go to Court. Please go with them to the next vignette: Courtroom.

The Courtroom: (Location: D108)

Task: They will follow the directions given to them by their lawyer prior to the audience arriving. Again, no talking unless the adult actors talk to them, look serious and to look straight ahead. They will be excused from court. Please go with them to the next vignette: Counseling.

Counseling: (Location: D106)

Task: They will follow the directions given to them by the counselor prior to the audience arriving. They will be excused from counseling. Please go with them to the next vignette: Party Scene.

The Party Scene: (Location: E100)

Task: At the scene, other actors will introduce themselves to the actor student. They will signal the student when they are to fall to the ground. The instructions to the student are that once on the ground, they are to pretend they are unconscious. The Medics will be working on them. The student they will be placed on a gurney and wheeled out of the scene. They are to remain silent and are not to move. As they are being wheeled away from this scene, their “actor parent / sibling” will be outside the room and will be asking them questions that they will need to answer. Please go with the student to the next vignette: Emergency Room. As you are waiting with them in the “wings” you can remind the student that in the scene they will be pronounced dead and that they are to remain still and quiet.

The Emergency Room: (Location: F111)

Task: At the scene the instructions to the student is to remain still and quiet. You, the student, and the Medics will enter the vignette AFTER the audience is seated. You can find a place to stand near the audience. The doctor and nurse will work on the, but they will be pronounced dead. Their “actor parent / sibling” will come in. They will be wheeled out of the scene again. The student will now end the acting portion of their day. They will NOT participate in the *Funeral* scene. Please take them to Molly’s Story in L103. There will be a group in there already, so please wait. While waiting,

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simply talk with them about their experience. This will help them during the debriefing. Make sure the student is in the *Debriefing* room before their group arrives.

Molly's Story: (Location: L103)

Task: The student is done acting for the day and will join the rest of their group for this powerful piece.

The Debriefing: (B103)

Task: All students will participate in a debriefing session with law enforcement / assigned leader.
